Relating to Casualty Condition	Little or no communication relating to casualty's condition	Regular communication relating to casualty's condition informing IC and team members of injuries.	Continuous communication relating to casualty's condition informing IC and team members of injuries. Monitoring casualty during rescue so it can be stopped at any point.			
Casualty Handover	Limited information given about casualty.	Adequate information given about casualty.	Extensive information given about casualty, including injuries, signs and symptoms and treatment given.
