

UKRO Board Meeting – 22nd July '22 – Update for Website Tab:

- Memorandum of Understanding between PROF, Institute of Vehicle Recovery (IVR), NFCC, National Police Chiefs Council (NPCC) and National Highways formally signed 14 July 2022;
- 2022 National Rescue Challenge in Birmingham - 79 teams overall have entered the challenge;
- UKRO currently working with NFCC and producing videos/webinars which showcases current issues in FRS Sector. NFCC/UKRO Clinical governance video filmed. Currently in editing. Next one planned for Sept '22 and focuses on EXiT Project Extrication principles. Future ones will focus on IDP and work of the Global directorate;
- The Board has approved a revised Health & Safety Policy and revised Quality Policy – See link below;
- Recent survey carried out by new volunteers within UKRO in Communications & Marketing Team. They have administered a survey to FRS's asking what they know about UKRO, what participation they have, what they would like etc. It had a 40% response rate and consideration now needs to be given for the future regards the results;
- UKRO Risk Register was updated to reflect current issues facing the Charity;
- Latest update from the IFE is that there is very little work required to provide a qualification for the extrication framework;
